**QUIT CLAIM DEED,**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

**This Indenture**, Made this 28th day of September A. D., 1906 between W. W. McAllister and Lizzie McAllister, his wife of Indian Territory District, party of the first part, and E. L. Wickizer of Indian Territory party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One 7-00/100 dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the  Creek Nation, Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The North half (1/2) of Lot No. Five (5) in Block No. One Hundred fifty-two (152) in the town of Tulsa, as shown by the Government plat thereof

This deed is made to correct Quit Claims Deed of June 19, 1905, as to name, etc., which said deed was duly filed for record at Sapulpa, Ind. Ter. July 6, 1905, in Book "T" at Page 14.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Lizzie McAllister wife of the said W. W. McAllister for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. L. Wickizer

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
