This Indenture, Made this 2nd day of November A. D. 1906 between Nora B. Roth nee Nora B. Burgess and Andrew Roth her husband his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and Carrie V. Hansen of Tulsa, D. T. party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, forever, all her right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the town of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

North 46-2/3 feet of Lot Four (4) and South 20 feet of Lot Three (3) in Block Three (3), Tulsa, Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Andrew Roth wife of the said husband of the said Nora B. Roth for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Carrie V. Hansen all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
