nesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of 1.00 and the valuable considerations dollars,  
in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these  
presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim  
and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the City of Tulsa, I.T.  
Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

Lots (1) One (2) Two & (3) Three in Block (4) one situated in Grandview Addition to the  
City of Tulsa, I.T.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, inter-  
est and claim whatever of the said part of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said part of the second part,  
heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Olive S. Houck & Minnie E. Adams  
wife of the said Adrian Houck & George W. Adams  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. S. Waddell

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
