do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Maurice W. Le Vinna and Etta M. Le Vinna,
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
Cherokee Nation
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered seven (7) in block numbered five (5) in North Tulsa, Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated October 13th 1906
and recorded October 18, 1906 in Book 12 at Page 129 of the records of the U.S. Court, Cherokee, I.T.
Maurice W. Le Vinna and Etta M. Le Vinna conveying said real estate to
John L. Mitchell to secure the pay-
ment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
