

# QUIT CLAIM DEED,

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

This Indenture, Made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of February A. D. 1907 between Agnes Harris, and her husband,

 part, and C. F. Singley of Tulsa, I.T. party of the second part, wit-  
 neseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) dollars  
 in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), and other consideration, have  
 presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim  
 and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the City of Tulsa  
 Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to wit:

All of Lot One (1) in Block Twenty One, not owned by the M. & O.  
R.R. Co. and all of Lot six (6) in Block Twenty One (21) was owned by the  
M. & O. R.R. Co. all of said property being situated in the said City of Tulsa,  
Indian Territory as shown by the original plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular t<sup>e</sup> appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, inter-  
 est and claim whatever of the said part ed of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part,  
his heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Sam Harris, husband of the said Agnes Harris  
wife of the said

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. F. Singley,  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
