QUIT CLAIM DEED,

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

This Indenture, Made this 13th day of March A. D., 1907 between A. B. Campbell
and Mary M. Campbell his wife of Indian Territory District, party of the first
part, and Edward McCay and J. L. Cook of Tulsa, I.T. party of the second part, wit-
nesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (41.00)
dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these
presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim
and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the City of Tulsa
Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot six (6) and the North Half (1/2) of Lot Five (5) in Block One
Hundred and Fifty-one (151) of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory,
according to the official plat thereof.

This deed given to correct the acknowledgment in a certain
deed, dated the 23rd day of May, 1905, filed for record on the 27th day
of May, 1905, at 5 P.M. given by A. B. Campbell and Mary M.
Campbell, his wife to W. C. Campbell.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, inter-
est and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part,
in their heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Mary M. Campbell
wife of the said A. B. Campbell,

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Edward McCay and J. L. Cook all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
