This Indenture, Made this 28 day of March A. D. 1907 between Arthur F Antle and Leona Antle his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and F.M. Machevorn of Tulsa Indian Territory, party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$100) Dollars

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the City of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

all of Lot number six (6) and the north half of Lot number five (5) in Block number one hundred ninety seven (197) in the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory according to the official plat thereof. This deed is made to correct the description and name as contained in a deed made March 18<sup>th</sup> 1907 by Arthur F. Antle and Leona Antle to same property, which was filed for record at Tulsa Indian Territory on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1907, at 9:40 o'clock a.m. to the same grantors.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Leona Antle wife of the said Arthur F. Antle for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
