

DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT I John H. Cress,

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Mary W. Krieger and H. W. Krieger her husband do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Mary W. Krieger and H. W. Krieger and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The West half of Block number 12 Two. With the exception of Lots 22 & 23 of said Block, all of Block number 3, all of Block number 4 except Lots 8, 9, and 10 of said Block, the above land is known as a part of the Oklahoma Addition. And is more particularly described as a part of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of section one, in Township 19 N., Range 12 E., also Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 of Block number 9; and Lot 1 Block 12 of Burnett Addition to Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated November 4th 1904 and recorded November 18 1905 in Book L at Page 22 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by Mary W. Krieger and H. W. Krieger her husband conveying said real estate to John H. Cress to secure the payment of one certain note for \$1200 therein named, the same having been fully paid.
