

DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT Clarissa Bell

for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by Geo. W. Adams of Tulsa, D.T.
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said George W. Adams
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

20 1/2 acres off West side of S 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 7 Township 18 Range 13 except the following:
Beginning at a point 360 feet East of SW corner of said tract running thence East 360 feet, thence North
300 feet, thence West 360 feet, thence South 300 feet to Beginning.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated April 10th 1906
and recorded 4/19/ 1906 in Book at Page of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
George W. Adams conveying said real estate to
Clarissa Bell to secure the pay-
ment of 1 certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
