do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said U. W. Knott, H. L. Reed and Minnie Reed
his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in

City of North Tulsa, Indian Territory
the Eight District of the Indian Territory, to wit: The South 22 feet of Lot 4, all of Lot 5, north 15 feet Lot 6, and part of Lot 14 described as follows. Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 14 in Block 11, thence running Northwesterly along line between Lots 14 and 15, 186.2 feet; thence Southeastly along line between Lots 6 and 14, 15 feet; thence Southwesterly parallel to and 85 feet distant from line between Lots 8 and 14 to block line thence north along block line to place of beginning.
