

QUIT CLAIM DEED.

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

This Indenture, Made this 18 day of May, A. D., 1907 between Charles L. Reeder
and Jessica V. Reeder his wife of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first
part, and Annie E. Rodgers of Pawhuska party of the second part, wit-

nesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollars,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these

presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim

and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the City of Tulsa

Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to-wit:

The most twenty five 25 feet of Lot five (5) in
Block Seventy five (75) in the Town of Tulsa
Western District of the Indian Territory

This deed is made to correct deed made
by same parties to same land and dated Febru
ary 1st 1904 in which the name of Rodgers
was spelled Rogers instead of Rodgers

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, inter-

est and claim whatever of the said part ies of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said part of the second part,

to her heirs and assigns, forever.

And I, Jessica V. Reeder
wife of the said Charles L. Reeder

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Annie E. Rodgers

all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
