WITNESSETH: That the said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of no. 100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do as hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said part 1st of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit:

All my undivided one half interest in Lot twenty (20) in Block forty seven (47) located in the Town of Collinsville Indian Territory according to the United States Government plat and survey of said town and all improvements of whatever name or nature located thereon. The party of second part to pay the remaining part of Government appraisal thereon.

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____,

for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 1st of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said part 1st of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
