do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Melissa E. Thomas

The South Half of Lot number Four (4) in Block number One Hundred seventy (170) in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory according to the U.S. plat and survey thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated November 11, 1904 filed for record in 1904 and recorded November 14, 1904 in Book L at Page 323 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by

Melissa E. Thomas, a single woman conveying said real estate to the undersigned, Loren Conway to secure the payment of two certain notes \$25.00 each therein named, the same having been fully paid.
