# DEED OF RELEASE.

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT Standard Banking and Trust Company, a Corporation By its President Grant C. Stebbins and H. B. Tally its Secretary  
for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to <sup>them</sup> paid by Jimmie H. Martinis and E. L. Martinis  
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Jimmie H. Martinis and E. L. Martinis  
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Half of lot 6, Block 196 in the Town of Tulsa Creek Nation, Ind. Terr. and according to the Official Survey and Plat of said Town.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated March 16th 1906  
and recorded March 27 1906 in Book L at Page 540 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
Jimmie H. Martinis and E. L. Martinis conveying said real estate to  
Standard Banking and Trust Company to secure the pay-  
ment of a certain Note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
