do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said John H. Middleton  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
the North Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, and the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of section Four (4), Township twenty-two (22) North,  
Range Thirteen (13) East and containing fifty (50) acres more or less.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Charles Hyde, dated May 21st, 1906  
and recorded 1906 in Book 1906 at Page 1906 of the records of the North Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
George Townsend and Laura Townsend, his wife conveying said real estate to
