and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South fifty (50) feet of Lot five (5) in Block One Hundred and Forty five (145) of the Town of Tulsa Indian Territory

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Real Estate Mortgage dated August 2nd 1905  
and recorded Aug 9th 1905 in Book Q at Page 115 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
R. C. Harrison conveying said real estate to  
C. W. Smith to secure the pay-  
ment of one certain note therein named, the same having been fully paid.
