

DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Mary L. Owen and Percy Owen
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

1/2 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 and S 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 20 N, Range 13 East,
containing 40 acres more or less as the case may be.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated April 5th 1906
and recorded April 6 1906 in Book 9 at Page 543 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by
Mary L. Owen and Percy Owen conveying said real estate to
C. W. Smith to secure the pay-
ment of a certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid. ||
