for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me paid by John H. Myers  
do hereby, grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said John H. Myers and Katie Myers, his wife  
and unto them heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in  
Creek Nation, District  
the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot numbered Four (4) Block numbered Twenty seven (27) in the town (now city) of Tulsa,  
Indian Territory according to U.S. plat and survey thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated August 2, 1905  
and recorded Aug 4, 1905 at 847900 in Book 10 at Page 111 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by  
John H. Myers and Katie Myers, his wife, conveyed conveying said real estate to  
Gladia Callcott to secure the pay-  
ment of one <sup>note</sup> certificat for \$400 due Aug 2, 1906 therein named, the same having been fully paid.
