TRANSFERABLE ONLY WITH CONSENT OF THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR.

OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT, CREEK NATION, INDIAN TERRITORY.

(Sect 17, Activing 10, 102 11 State 100 1)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 22day ofA.D. 19.03, by and between

WITNESSETH, That the part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the Royalties, Covenants, Stipulations, and Conditions hereinafter contained,
and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the part you of the second part le heirs, successors, and assigns, do hereby Demise, Grant, and
Let unto part aof the second part, Il heirs, successors, and assigns, for the term of years from date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural
gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the Greek Indian Nation, and within the Indian Territory, to wit: The Sutgest and Whotes Tender Sung Nungset and Set get Sung Sung Nungset and Set get get and Sung Nungset and Set get get get get get get get get get g
of Section J., Township 20, Range 4, of the Indian Meridian and containing 80
acres, more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine, and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and to use so much only of the
surface of said land as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, refining and removing such oil and natural
gas, including also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land, by means of pipe lines or otherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said
operations, and including still further the right to use such oil and natural gas as fuel so far as it is necessary to the prosecution of said operations.
In consideration of which the party of the second part hereby agreed and binds, stacks, heirs, successors, and assigns, to pay or cause to be paid to the
United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Indian Territory, for the Lessor, as royalty, the sum of ten per cent of the gross proceeds, on the leased premises, of
all crude oil extracted from the said land, such payment to be made at the time of sale or disposition of the oil; and the Lessee shall pay, in yearly payments, at
the end of each year, One Hundred and Fifty Dollars royalty on each gas-producing well which shall use. The Lesson shall have the free use of gas for
lighting and warming his residence on the premises. It is further agreed that a failure on the part of the Lesseeto use a gas-producing well, where the same can
not be reasonably utilized at the rate so prescribed, shall not work a forfeiture of this Lease so far as the same relates to mining oil, but if the Lesseedesired to
retain gas-producing privileges shall pay a royalty of Fifty Dollars per annum, in advance, on each gas-producing well not utilized, the first payment to

become due and to be made within thirty days from the date of the discovery of gas.

And the part of the second part further agree and binda, wall heirs, successors, and assigns to pay, or cause to be paid to the said agent, for Lessor. as advance annual royalty on this Lease, the sums of money as follows, to wit: Fifteen Cents per arrow per annum, in advance, for the first and second years; Thirty Cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the third and fourth years, and Seventy-five Cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the fifth and each succeeding year thereafter of the term for which this Lease is to run; it being understood and agreed that said sums of money so paid shall be a credit on the stipulated royalties; and further, that should the part-of the second part, neglect or refuse to pay such advance annual royalty for the period of sixty days after the same becomes due and payable, the Secretary of the Interior, after ten days notice to the parties, may declare this Lease null and void, and all royalties paid in advance shall become the money and property of the Lessor

The part of the second part further covenants and agree to exercise diligence in the sinking of wells for oil and natural gas on the lands covered by this se, and to drill at least one well thereon within twelve months from the date or approval of the bond by the Secretary of the Interior, and should the part. of the second part fail, neglect, or reluse to drill at least one well within the time stated, this Lease may, in the discretion of the Secretary, be declared null and void, after ten days notice to the parties; provided that the Lesseeshall have the privilege of delaying operations for a period not exceeding five years from the date or the approval or the bond to be furnished in connection herewith, by paying to the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Indian Territory, for the use and benefit of the Lessor....., in addition to the required annual advanced royalty, the sum of One Dollar per acre per annum for each leased tract remaining undeveloped, but the Lessee.....nay be required to immediately develop the tracts leased, should the Secretary of the Interior so determine that the interests of the Lessor....demand such action.

The part_____of the second part further agree to carry on operations in a workmanlike manner to the fullest possible extent, unavoidable casualties excepted; to promptly surrender and return the premises upon the termination of this Lease to the part.....of the first part or to whomsoever shall be lawfully entitled thereto, and not to remove therefrom any buildings of permanent improvements erected thereon during the said term by the said part, of the second part, but said buildings and improvements shall remain a part of said land and become the property of the owner of the land as a part of the consideration of this Lease, in addition to the other considerations herein specified, excepting the tools, boilers, boiler houses, pipe lines; pumping and drilling outlits, tanks, engines, and machinery, and the easing of all dry, or exhausted wells, shall remain the property of the said part y....of the second part, and may be removed at any time before the expiration of sixty days from the termination of the lease; that will not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under control, nor allow any intoxicating liquors to be sold or given away for any nurposes on such premises; thatwill not use such premises for any other purposes than those authorized in this Lease, and that before abandoning any well... ...will securely plug the same so as to effectually shut off all water above the oil bearing horizon.

And the said part of the second part further covenant and agree that will keep an accurate account of all oil-mining operations, showing the sales, prices, dates, purchasers, and the whole amount of oil mined or removed; and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on all implements, tools, movable machinery, and all other personal chattels, used in said prospecting and mining operations, and upon all of the unsold oil obtained from the land herein leased, as security for the payment of said royalty.

And it is mutually understood and agreed that this Indenture of Lease shall in all respects be subject to the rules and regulations heretofore on that hereafter be lawfully prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior relative to oil and gas leases in the Creek-Nation, and that this Lease, or any interest therein, shall not, by lations, or provisions of this Lease, or any of the regulations, or fail for the period of sixty days to pay the stipulated royalties provided for herein, then Secretary of the Interior, after ten days from notice to the parties hereto, shall have the right to avoid this Indenture of Lease and cancel the same, and when all the rights, franchises, and privileges, of the Lessee..., sub-lessees, heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns hereunder, shall cease and end without resorting to the courts and without further proceedings, and the Lessor shall be entitled to immediate possession of the leased land and the permanent improyements located thereon.
