

QUIT CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 15th, day of January, in the year A. D., 1909, between J. M. Hall, J. M. Gillette and C. W. Gillette, being all the directors of the Fidelity Trust Company, a corporation on the date of its dissolution, and Trustees of such corporation dissolved of the first part, and J.M. Gillette of the Second part.
