

Southwest Quarter (~~1~~) of Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twelve (12), Township Twenty One (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, containing 50 acres, more or less, same being her surplus allotment.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, unto the said party of the first part from the 1st, day of March 1909 to the 1st day of March 1914.

And the party of the second part in consideration of the leasing the premises, as above set forth covenants and agrees with the said party of the first part, to pay the said party of the first part, her heirs or assigns, as rent for the same the total amount or sum of Sixty two & 50/100 (\$62.50) Dollars, in yearly payments as follows, to wit:

Twelve & 50/100 Dollars (\$12.50) cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and Twelve & 50/100 Dollars (\$12.50) to be paid on or before the 1st day of March of each year during life of this lease.

HEREBY WAIVING the benefit of exemption, valuation and appraisement laws of said State of Oklahoma, to secure the payment thereof.

The covenants herein shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors and administrators of the parties of this lease.
