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DECLARATION OF TRUST.

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 21st, day of January, A. D., 1909, between the First United Presbyterian Church of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a church corporation, of the first part, and the Trustees of the General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church of North America, of the second part.

WITNESSETH: THAT, WHEREAS, the said parties of the second part and their different organizations have been instrumental in the acquisition of the property hereinafter described, and the buildings thereon of a certain parsonage, to be occupied by the minister of the party of the first part.

AND, WHEREAS, it is the desire of the party of the first part to protect the interest of the said parties of the second part, the said party of the first part, by its Trustees and pursuant to a resolution passed by the congregation of the said party of the first part at a call meeting, on the 23 day of Dec. 1908, proper and legal notice of the same having been given, that the said Trustees of the party of the first part were authorized and empowered to execute and deliver to the parties of the second part this declaration of Trust, according to the laws of the said parties of the second part.

AND, WHEREAS, by the instrumentality of the said parties of the second part, the party of the first part has acquired the following described property:

The South Fifty (50) feet of Lot Six (6) in Block Nine (9) North, Tulsa, Oklahoma, with the buildings thereon.

NOW, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the premises, it is hereby agreed that the said party of the first part, its successors and assigns, agrees and binds itself <sup>that</sup> the said above described lot or parcel of land shall be used and kept, maintained <sup>and</sup> disposed of, as a place of residence for the use of the minister of the First United Presbyterian Church of Tulsa, Oklahoma, subject to the standards and acts of the United Presbyterian Church of North America, as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Assembly of said Church; and in case the First United Presbyterian Church of Tulsa, Oklahoma, shall cease to exist, <sup>be dissolved</sup> or cease to be connected with and subject to the jurisdiction of the General Assembly of said Church, or shall loose its corporate existence, the trust shall terminate and the title shall vest absolutely in the Trustees of the General Assembly of the United
