WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the secondpart, the receipt whareof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, and to her successors and assigns forever, all of the following described tract, piece or parcel of land, lying and situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma/ to wit:

The South One Half  $(S_2^1)$  of the Northwest Quarter (NW $_1^1$ ) of Section Thirty Five (35) in Township Twenty Two (22) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 80 acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, with all and singular the tenements, heridatements and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and all rights of homestead exemption unto the said party of the secondpart, and to her heirs and assigns forever.
