R. McKee, of Enid, Oklahoma, all of the above described premises for a term of years ending on the 11th, day of November, 1909, for grazing purposes.

And I covenant with the said W. R. McKee, that I, My heirs and assigns will protect the said W. R. McKee, his heirs and assigns in a quiet and peaceful possession of the above described land for the full term of this lease.
