

surviving him as his only heirs this petitioner, Jennie Hickory, nee Coney, who is his daughter and One Tom Hickory, a minor, his son, and that there have been no children born to the said Moses Coney since the 4th day of March, 1906..

The Court further finds that on the 24th, day of February, 1909, the petitioner Jennie Hickory, nee Coney, made/ executed and delivered a deed of conveyance to John F? Hayden, thereby conveying to the said John F?. Hayden all her right, title and interest in and to the lands above described, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, which consideration the court finds is adequate, and which deed has been exhibited to the court.

IT IS THEREFORE, by the Court considered, ordered and adjudged and decreed that the said deed above described, be and the same is hereby approved, according to Section 9, of the Act of Congress, approved May 27, 1908, entitled an act for the removal of Restriction from a part of the lands of the allottees of the Five Civilized Tribes; and for other purposes".
