WHEREAS, On the 16th, day of January, 1909, John Fain and Charlotte Fain, his wife, made and entered into ~~certain~~ oil and gas mining lease with James Bowen, A. B. Norton and John O. Mitchell, all of Tulsa, Oklahoma; and,

WHEREAS, said lease was filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, January 22, 1909, in record 51, page 151; and,
