CONFIRMATORY ORDER.

And now on this the 24 day of February, 1909, comes on for hearing and approval the report of the sale and execution of leases for oil and gas mining purposes upon the lands of the wards herein made by Nathaniel D. Willis, as the guardian of the said wards to the said The Lucas Oil Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the said Guardian appearing in person and by his attorneys, Teehee & Johns, and the Court having examined the said report and having heard and considered the evidence offered in support of the said report, and being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That pursuant to an order of this court made and entered on the 5th, day of February, 1909, authorizing the said guardian to advertise for and sell leases for oil and gas mining purposes upon the lands of his wards, the said guardian on the 23rd, day of February 1909, sold oil and gas mining leases upon the following lands of his wards, described as follows, to-wit:

Commercial lease upon the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Twp. 20 North, Range 14 E., containing 70 acres, more or less, situated in Tulsa County, ~~of~~ State of Oklahoma, being the lands of Robert L. Willis; upon the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16, Twp. 20 North, Range 13 E., containing 60 acres, more or less, situated in Tulsa County of Said State, being lands of Charlie Willis; Upon the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Twp. 20 North, Range 14 E., containing 70 acres, ^{more or less} situated in Tulsa County of Said State, being the lands of Thomas E. Willis; upon the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, Twp 20 North, Range 14 E., containing 70 acres, more or less, situated in Tulsa County of said State, being the lands of Annie M. Willis; and upon the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Twp. 20 North, Range 14 E., containing 70 acres, more or less, situated in Tulsa County of said State, being the lands of James E. Willis, to the Lucas Oil Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Said leases to continue for the minority of each of said named wards, and as long ^{thereafter} as oil or gas is produced from premises in paying quantities.

And that the sum paid for said leases as stated in said report was the best and highest bid for said leases.

The said sale was made after due notice as prescribed by ^{the} said order of sale and that said guardian proceeded and managed said sale as by said order required and directed, and that said leases are in every respect executed in conformity therewith.

It is therefore, adjudged, ordered and decreed by this Court that the said leases for oil and mining purposes upon the lands of said wards hereinabove set out and described and made and executed by the said Nathaniel D. Willis as the guardian of the said named wards in favor of the Lucas Oil Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and the same are hereby approved.
