The Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Seven (27) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, also the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty One (31); also the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and Lot Three (3) of Section Thirty Two (32), of Township Eighteen (18) North, of Range Thirteen (13) East; with all the rights, privileges and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
