CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN M. N. BEWLEY, OF OWASSO, IND. TER. AND CORA LEE BEWLEY HIS WIFE, OF OWASSO, IND. TER.

Because of serious unpleasantness between M. N. Bewley and Cora Lee Bewley, his wife, especially as regards her treatment of M. N. Bewleys small children; the following contract was entered into upon the above day and date: Cora Lee Bewley of her own volition forsakes the bed and board of M. N. Bewley, her husband, M. N. Bewley agrees and is firmly bound to pay the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) without interest to the said Cora Lee Bewley, within two years from date, or at an earlier date, providing however, that, the said M. N. Bewley shall sell a certain farm owned by him, situated in the State of Kentucky, before the expiration of the two years, and Cora Lee Bewley, his wife, agrees to willingly sign deed for such conveyance of the aforementioned farm, when the five hundred dollars have been placed upon deposit for her, and the said Cora Lee Bewley agrees that when she has received the Five Hundred Dollars, that she will accept the same as her full interest in the M. N. Bewley estate, releasing all claims whatsoever against said estate. It is further agreed that should either parties to this contract apply for a divorce from the marriage relationship, when the five hundred dollars shall have been paid, that neither one of the parties will in any way seek to hinder the other partie from securing a divorce decree.
