COMPARED

OIL AND GAS LEASE.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made this fifth, day of March, A. D., 1909, between Arthur R. Perryman of Tulsa, Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and L. D. Savage, of Ellwood City, Lawrence Co., Pa., party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained and of the sum of One Hundred and Sixty Dollars (\$160.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby demise, let and grant unto the party of the second part all the oil and gas in and under all that certain tract of land, situate in Twp. 17 and 17, Township Wagoner and Tulsa Counties, State of Oklahoma, described as follows to-wit:

The West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West Twenty 20 acres of Lot Four 4 of Section Three (3), Township Seventeen (17) North and Range Fourteen (14) East, The East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty Three (33) and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty Four (34) Twp. 18 North and Range 14 East. Containing One Hundred and Twenty (120) acres more or less. The East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ and the East Twenty (20) acres of Lot One (1) of Section Four (4) Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, containing Forty (40) acres more or less. Together with the exclusive right to enter thereon at all times for the purpose of drilling and operating thereon for oil and gas or water, and to erect, maintain, and remove all buildings, structures, pipes, pipe lines and machinery necessary and convenient for the production storage and transportation of oil, gas and water.
