

When requested by the first party the second party shall bury pipe lines except steam lines below plough depth.

The part--- of the second part, shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

The party of the second part, its heirs, successors or assigns, shall have the right at any time on the payment of One (\$1.00) Dollars and all payable obligations then due to the party of the first part, her heirs or assigns, to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities hereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and terminate.

Second party agrees to pay to first party the sum of \$1.00 per year as rental on the above described premises, provided the royalties herein specified do not exceed said amount. Second party agrees to pay all damages it causes to growing crops on said land.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties hereto shall extend to their successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
