A MINOR, SARAH C. MARTIN, GUARDIAN.) ORDER CONFIRMING SALE OF OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

This matter coming on for hearing on this 16th, day of March 1909, and it appearing to the Court that Sarah C. Martin, the above named Guardian of William P. Martin, a minor, on the 1st, day of March, 1909, filed in this court her petition praying for an order authorizing and commanding her to lease for oil and gas mining purposes certain lands belonging to said minor, William P. Martin, which lands are located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and ^{are} more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, and The East Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 21, Range 13.

And it further appearing that the said Guardian's petition was heard on the 1st, day of March, 1909, and upon such hearing evidence was taken in open Court and it appearing to the Court that it would be for the best interest of said minor to lease said lands for oil and gas mining purposes, whereupon and when an order was made by this Court granting said petition, authorizing and commanding said Guardian to lease said lands for oil and gas mining purposes, and to give notice thereof by publication, for two ^{successive} ~~consecutive~~ weeks in the Tulsa Chief, a newspaper published in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And it further appearing that on the 16th, day of March, A. D. 1909, the said Guardian made her due and legal return of ^{said} sale and leasing under said order of Court, and it ~~father~~ appearing by such return, and by evidence taken in open court, that in conformity with, and according to the last said order of Court said Guardian, Sarah C. Martin, caused to be published a notice of the time and place of the leasing of said lands as above said, and that on the 16th day of March, 1909 she leased and rented said lands to F. B. Ufer, for oil and gas mining purposes, he being the best and highest purchaser and bidder for the same, and that said F. B. Ufer offers and agrees to pay the sum of Eleven Hundred and Fifty Dollars as bonus for the same, and one-eighth (1/8) of all the oil produced as royalty, and One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) dollars per year for each gas well drilled thereon from which gas is marketed, and free gas for one household, the sum to be paid to said guardian on behalf of said minor,
