RENTAL CONTRACT.

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into, this 10th day of March 1909, by and between Lasley Haynes and his wife Sukey Haynes, of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, party of the first part and J. M. Orrison of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the agreements and covenants of second party as herein set out, hereby lets, rents and demises unto second party, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, for agricultural purposes, for the full term of one year (1-yr.), beginning January 1st, 1910 and ending December 31st, 1910, the following described real estate and premises, to wit:

The South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 18 North, Range 14 East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And second party in consideration of the agreements of first party, as herein set out, agrees to pay first party as rental for said lands and premises as follows:

\$75.00 cash in advance, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, by the first parties herein \$125.00 on January 1st, 1910, to be paid at Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, together with interest thereon from this date at 8 per cent per annum. And second party further agrees that he will at the expiration of term of this contract deliver up to first party the premises herein rented in as good condition as when received by him under this contract, usual wear and unavoidable accidents excepted.
