DEED OF EXECUTRIX.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 19 day of March, 1908, by and between Emily M. Campbell of Tulsa Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, executrix of the last will and testament of Wilbur Emory Campbell, deceased, of the first part, and Mary E. Green and Mary Green Fiske, of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That whereas, under the terms of said last will and testament of said Wilbur Emory Campbell, decadent, said will having been admitted to probate in the County Court of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, on the 10th, day of December, 1907, power was given to the said executrix, Emily M. Campbell, to dispose of, in such manner as seemed to her fitting, any and all real estate decedent died seized of, and to sell and convey the same by good and sufficient warranty deeds; and,
