IN RE ESTATE OF MRS. MOON WALLACE, DECEASED) JOURNAL ENTRY

Now on this April 2, 1909, this matter coming on for hearing and determination upon the application of A. L. Haislip, for an order designating the heirs at law of Mrs. Moon Wallace deceased, and the Court having heard the evidence and the testimony of witnesses produced, sworn and examined, and being fully advised as to the law and the evidence, finds; That Mrs. Moon Wallace, died intestate, without issue, and without husband surviving her at the County of Roosevelt, in the Territory of New Mexico, on or about the 15th, day of April 1908 that she died seized and possessed of Lot One, Block Four in the town of Owasso, Oklahoma; that she left as her sole surviving heir at law her ^{Father} ~~brother~~ A. L. Haislip; that she left no personal property, and no debts.

It is therefore by the Court ordered, adjudged and decreed, that said A. L. Haislip is the sole surviving heir at law of Mrs. Moon Wallace, and as such heir is the owner of the property of which deceased died the owner, within Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

WARRANTY DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this....day of October, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight, by and between Olin T. Lewis, and Kirk L. Lewis, a single man, of Dawson, Oklahoma parties of the first part, and J. G. Hughes and Mary Hughes, of Dawson Oklahoma, parties of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Seventy Five and no/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said parties of the second part, the following described real estate and premises, situated in Dawson, Oklahoma to-wit:

Lot Number Two (2) in Block Number Fourteen (14) in the town of Dawson, State of Oklahoma. according to the recorded amended plat thereof. Together with all improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same. J. G. Hughes and Mary Hughes.

And I, Estella Lewis, wife of the said Olin T. Lewis, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said parties of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
