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OIL AND GAS LEASE. ~~CONFIRMED~~

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, 1909, by and between Soney Smith, Guardian of the person and Estate of Thomas Smith, a minor, party of the first part, and R. H. Shrewsbury and W. F. Daley, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, on the 25th, day of February, A. D. 1909, said first party as such Guardian made and entered into an oil and gas mining lease on certain real estate belonging to the said Thomas Smith, a minor, and described as follows, to wit:

THE S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  OF THE NW.  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 28, TP. 20 N., RANGE 13 E. <sup>located</sup> ~~located~~ in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and containing 80 acres, more or less. A portion of said property being reserved on terms set out in said lease.

AND WHEREAS, Said lease provides that said R. H. Shrewsbury and said W. F. Daley, second parties hereto, shall commence a well on some part of the SW.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28, Tp. 20 North, Range 13 E., in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, within 90 days from the cancellation by the Department of the Interior of a certain lease to the Penn Oil Company, on said property last mentioned,

AND WHEREAS, it was the intention of the parties to said lease dated the 25th, day of February as aforesaid, to give the lessees, Daley and Shrewsbury, 90 full days in which to commence said well mentioned above.
