WHEREAS Willey E. Chambers an allottee of the Cherokee Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

West Half (W/2) of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) and Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty Two (22) Township Twenty (20) North and Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 30 acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 140), and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of the proceeds; said removal of restrictions to be effective thirty days from date hereof.
