THE MUSKOGEE (CREEK) NATION, INDIAN TERRITORY.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING;

WHEREAS, a townsite commission, hereto fore appointed and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stat., 861) agreement ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901, has appraised the lots in the town of Bixby, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory; and,

WHEREAS, the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 10th day of ~~June~~ April 1902, and was duly placed on file; and,

WHEREAS, the said commission has appraised all of the ~~town~~ lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and,

WHEREAS, the said commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Andrew L. Hausam who has paid Sixty Seven & no/100 (\$67.00) Dollars, the full amount of the purchase price, into the Treasury of the United States, to the Credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee, Indian Territory, and is, therefore, entitled to a patent:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell, and convey unto the said Andrew L. Hausam, heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation aforesaid, in and to Lot Numbered 1, in Block numbered 15, in the Town of Bixby Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian Territory, and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
