## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION:-

BE IT KNOWN, That the undersigned citizens of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and do hereby certify:

## FIRST:

That the name of this corporation shall be The Macedonia Baptist Church, of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

## SECOND:

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to do missionary and educational work; to form a society of persons of the Missionary Baptist <sup>Church</sup> ~~Church~~. The general purposes of this corporation is to promote morality and uprightness of life among its members generally and to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ? Its general plan of operation is to preach the Gospel and convert sinners to belief in Christ and upon their confession and repentance to receive them as members, when favorably voted upon by the membership of this corporation.

Terms of admission are, that the applicant shall profess faith in Jesus Christ and accept baptism by immersion and these are the requisites for membership. Officers shall be selected by majority vote of members and vacancies filled in like manner. This corporation shall be governed by the laws, usages and commentaries of the Baptist Church as set out in "the New Directory <sup>for</sup> ~~of~~ Baptist Churches", by Edward T. Hiscox.

## THIRD:

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is at Tulsa, Oklahoma.

## FOURTH:

That the term for which <sup>the</sup> ~~this~~ corporation is to exist is perpetually.

## FIFTH:
