

DEED OF RELEASE.

ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS Chesley Starr, an allottee of the Creek nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described lands, to wit:

The Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 40 acres,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 140)/ and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of the proceeds; said removal of restrictions being effective thirty days from date hereof RM.
