IN THE MATTER OF THE GUARDIANSHIP OF SAMUEL GRAYSON, PRISCILLA GRAYSON, JULIA GRAYSON AND KATIE GRAYSON, MINORS, MARY GRAYSON, GUARDIAN.

ORDER OF COURT RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING AND APPROVING AN OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

This matter came on to be heard on this the 7th day of April 1909, upon the petition of Mary Grayson, Guardian of Samuel Grayson, Priscilla Grayson, Julia Grayson and Katie Grayson, asking for an order of court approving and confirming her action in making and executing for and on behalf of said minors an oil and gas mining lease, unto Charles Page, and which said lease has been presented to this court for approval.

The petitioner appearing in person, and by her attorneys Abbott & Brown, and the Court after hearing the testimony of the petitioner and testimony of disinterested witnesses as to the value of the minors interests in and to the lands hereinafter described, for oil and gas mining purposes and after hearing the argument of counsel and being fully advised in the premises finds:

That the allegations contained in the said Petition are true, that the said Mary Grayson is the legally appointed, qualified and acting guardian of the said minors, that said minors are of the age as follows, to-wit: Samuel Grayson 16, years; Priscilla Grayson 15 years, Julia Grayson 13 years and Katie Grayson 10 years, that said minors, as the heirs at law of Robert Grayson, deceased, are seized of an undivided four ninths of two thirds interest, collectively, in and to the lands hereinafter described, that said Robert Grayson the father of said minors died in the month of November 19 08, seized and possessed of the following described land, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 19 North, Range 13 East.

That said minors are four of the nine heirs at law who take an undivided two thirds interest in and to said estate.

The court further finds that on the 6th, day of April 1909, all of the heirs including the Guardian for said minors, joined in making and executing an oil and gas mining lease embracing the land above described, running to Charles Page under and by virtue of the terms of which lease the bonus is the sum of One Dollar per acre and the royalty to be paid thereunder is one eighth of the oil produced and the further bonus of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for each producing gas well.
