ORDER OF COURT.

And now on this 17th, day of April 1909, comes on to be heard the application of Fronie Parks to have conferred upon her the rights of majority.

The petitioner and W. M. Franklin, her next friend appearing in person, and by her attorney Wm. A. Green, and thereupon the applicant introduced her testimony, and after hearing the same, and the court being fully advised in the premises fdoth find:

That the said Fronie Parks is a person of sound mind and able to transact her own affairs and that the said applicant is over the age of eighteen years.

The Court further finds that the said Fronie Parks is a bona fide resident of Wagoner County State of Oklahoma, and has been for more than one year last past next before the filing of her petition herein.

The Court further finds that the publication notice as required by law has been duly and legally made, and the Court hereby approves the same.

Therefore, it is by the Court considered, ordered and adjudged, that the rights of magority be, and the same are hereby conferred upon the said Fornie Parks to this extent, and for the following purposes, to-wit:

For the purpose of executing an oil and gas mining lease on her lands allotted to her, and that she may make and all necessary contracts for the purpose of carrying onnto effect said lease, and that she may sell or otherwise dispose of her lands so allotted to her; and that each and all of her said acts so authorized shall have the same force and effect as though done by one at the age of majority.

and this order empowers the said Fronie Parks and removes her disabilities so as to invest her with all the powers and subject her to all of the liabilities and obligations which she would have and be subjected to in she had actually reached her majority in accordance with the records of the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes concerning said above mentioned transaction.
