That the said living heirs of said Anderson Johnson are full blood citizens of the Creek Nation of Indians, and come within Section Nine of the Act of Congress of May 27th, 1908, providing for the sale of the land of deceased allottees.

And it being further shown to the Court that on May 3rd, 1909, said petitioners executed and delivered to J. F. of Bixby Oklahoma, a warranty deed covering said above described premises for consideration of Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1200.00).

And it being shown by testimony of free holders living in the neighborhood of the location of said land that the said sum is a fair and just Price for said land and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that said deed should be approved.
