shall remain a part of said landand become the property of the owner of the landas a part of the condideration for this lease, excepting the tols, derricks, boiler houwes, pipe lines, pumping and drilling outfits, tanks, engines and machinery and the casing of all dry or exausted wells, which shall remain the property of the lessee, and may be removed at any time prior to sixty days after the termination of this lease; shall not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under lessee's control, shall not use such premises for any other p purposes than those authorized in this lease, and before abandoning any well shall securely plug the same so as effectually to shut off all the water from the oil - bearing stratum, or in the manner required by the Laws of the State of Oklahoma.

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5. The lessee shall keep and accurate account of all oil mining operations, showing sales, prices, dates, purchasers, and the whole amount of oil mined or removed; and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on all implements, tools, movable machinery, and all other personal chattels used in operating said property, and upon all the unsold oil obtained from the land herein leased, as security for the payment of said royalty.

6. The lessee may at any time, by paying the lessor all amounts then due as provided herein and the further sum of One Dollar, surrender and cancel this lease and be relieved from all further obligations or liability hereunder: Provided if this lease has been recorded, lessee shall execute a release and record the same in the proper county recording office: Provided further, the lessee may surrender all the undeveloped portion of the leased premises, by paying the lessor all amounts then due and the further sum of One Dollar, which surrender shall not affect the terms chereof as to each producing well and ten acres of Band premises as nearly in square form as possible next contiguous to and surrounding each of said wells, and execute and record a cancellation of the premises surrendered.

7. Assignment of this lease or any interest thereinmay be made at any time.

8. Each addevery clause and covenant of this indenture shall extend to the heirs, executors administrators, successors and lawful assigns of the parties hereto.
