AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the 3rd day of October, A. D. 1909, by and between

Fannie B. Lynch & William Lynch, husband and wife, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and G. T. Braden, of Pittsburg, Pennsylvania, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to them in hand well and truly paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the said party of the second part, to be paid, kept and performed, have granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents do grant, demise, lease and let unto the said party of the first part, their heirs, administrators, executors, successors, or assigns, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines and of building tanks, stations and structures thereon to take care of said products, all that certain tract of land, situate in the town of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of this State; bounded substantially as follows:

On the North by lands of  
On the East by lands of  
On the South by lands of  
On the West by lands of

Containing eighty (80) acres, more or less, and being same land conveyed to the first parties by Cheyenne Nation by deed bearing date 1, reserving, however, therefrom three hundred feet around the buildings on which no wells shall be drilled by either party except by mutual consent.

It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of ten years from this date and as long thereafter as oil or gas, or either of them, is produced from said land by the part of the second part, their heirs, administrators, executors, successors or assigns.

In consideration of the premises, the said party of the second part covenant, and agree: 1st—To deliver to the credit of the parties of the first part, their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, free of cost in the pipe line to which part of the second part may connect two wells the equal or eighth part of all oil produced and saved from the leased premises: And 2nd—To pay Seventy-five (75) Dollars each three months in advance for the gas, from each and every gas well drilled on said premises, the gas from which is marketed and used off the premises, while the gas from said well is so marketed and used when marketed or sold in bulk.

Second part of covenant and agree to locate all wells so as to interfere as little as possible with the cultivated portion of the farm. And further, to complete a well on said premises within three months from the date hereof, or pay at the rate of Seventy-five (75) Dollars, quarterly in advance, for each additional three months such completion is delayed from the time above mentioned for the completion of such well until a well is completed; and it is agreed that the completion of such well shall be and operate as a full liquidation of all rental under this provisions during the remainder of the term of this lease. Such payments may be made direct to the lessor or deposited to their credit in Bank of Oklahoma, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

First part is to have gas free for fuel and light in the dwelling on said premises by making their own connections to any well thereon except from wells. It is agreed that the second part shall have the privilege of using sufficient water, oil and gas from said premises to run all machinery necessary for drilling and operating thereon, and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and further, upon the payment of five dollars per acre, shall acquire all rights, claims, at any time, by the part of second part, their heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, to the parties of the first part, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, said party of the second part, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, shall have the right to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine, and this lease become absolutely null and void.
