AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the 24th day of March, A. D. 1910, by and between Jacob I. Harlow  
Guardian of Rosa I. Harlow, minor of Owasso  
 County of Pulaski, State of Oklahoma, part 4 of the first part, and \_\_\_\_\_ part 4 of the second part;  
G. T. Braden of Pittsburgh, Pa.

WITNESSETH, That the said part 4 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to \_\_\_\_\_ in hand well and truly paid by the said part 4 of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the said part 4 of the second part, to be paid, kept and performed, has \_\_\_\_\_ granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents does \_\_\_\_\_ grant, demise, lease and let unto the said part 4 of the second part, \_\_\_\_\_ heirs, administrators, executors, successors, or assigns, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines and of building tanks, syphons and structures thereon to take care of said products, all that certain tract of land, situate in the \_\_\_\_\_

County of Pulaski, State of Oklahoma, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of this State; bounded substantially as follows:  
 On the North by lands of S 1/4 of S 1/4 of S 6 1/4 of Section 1; S 6 1/4 of N 6 1/4; S 1/2 of S 1/4 of N 6 1/4  
 On the East by lands of and N 6 1/4 of S 1/4 of N 6 1/4 of Section 13. T 20 N, R 13 E. S. 1 B 7 M  
 On the South by lands of \_\_\_\_\_  
 On the West by lands of \_\_\_\_\_

Containing Eighty (80) acres, more or less, and being same land conveyed to the first part 4 by Charles Nation by deed bearing date \_\_\_\_\_, reserving, however, therefrom 200 feet

around the buildings on which no wells shall be drilled by either party except by mutual consent. It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of ten years from this date and as long thereafter as oil or gas, or either of them, is produced from said land by the part 4 of the second part, \_\_\_\_\_ heirs, administrators, executors, successors or assigns.

In consideration of the premises, the said part 4 of the second part covenant, and agree: 1st—To deliver to the credit of the party \_\_\_\_\_ of the first part, \_\_\_\_\_ heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, free of cost in the pipe line to which part 4 of the second part may connect \_\_\_\_\_ wells the equal one eighth part of all oil produced and saved from the leased premises: And 2nd—To pay Fifty (50.00) Dollars each three months in advance for the gas, from each and every gas well drilled on said premises, the gas from which is marketed and used on the premises, while the gas from said well is so marketed and used.

Second part 4 covenant and agree to locate all wells so as to interfere as little as possible with the cultivated portion of the farm. And further, to complete a well on said premises within three months from the date hereof, or pay at the rate of Twenty (20.00) Dollars, quarterly in advance, for each additional three months such completion is delayed from the time above mentioned for the completion of such well until a well is completed; and it is agreed that the completion of such well shall be and operate as a full liquidation of all rental under this provisions during the remainder of the term of this lease. Such payments may be made direct to the lessor \_\_\_\_\_ or deposited to \_\_\_\_\_ credit in the Central National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Representative herein had to confirming made herein by County Court, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on March 24, 1910 and recorded at page 603, Book 78-6 Record Register of Deeds Office, Tulsa County Oklahoma, on March 24, 1910.

First part 4 to have gas free for fuel and light in the dwelling on said premises by making \_\_\_\_\_ own connections to any well thereon. It is agreed that the second part 4 shall have the privilege of using sufficient water, oil and gas from said premises to run all machinery necessary for drilling and operating thereon, and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and further, upon the payment of One Dollars, at any time, by the part 4 of second part, \_\_\_\_\_ heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, to the part 4 of the first part, \_\_\_\_\_ heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, said part 4 of the second part, \_\_\_\_\_ heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, shall have the right to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine, and this lease become absolutely null and void.
