DEED - General Warranty. - RAILROADS WORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN. No. 19787

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 5th day of May, A. D. 1929, between Leo A. O'Brien and Alice M. O'Brien

WITNESSETH, The said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred sixty eight and 75 CENTS DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do, by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots eleven (11) and (12) twelve in block (14) fourteen in Block (14) Okla according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining forever.

O'Brien for themselves heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; arising by or through said first parties, and any and all persons claiming by through or under them and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
