THIS INDENTURE, Made this Twenty-seventh day of July, A. D. 1909, between

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three thousand

(\$3000.00) and no DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
