THIS INDENTURE, Made this 19<sup>th</sup> day of *September*, A.D. 1909, between *Pearl A. Walsh and T. J. Walsh her husband*  
*Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and W. D. Bayan*

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of *\$50000**Five Thousand*and *no* DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of the second part,  
*her* heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*  
*and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Lot six (6) in Block Two (2) in Block*  
*addition to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma according to*  
*the recorded plat thereof.*

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
anywise appertaining forever.

And said *Pearl A. Walsh and T. J. Walsh her husband*  
for *their* heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part,  
that at the delivery of these presents, *they were* lawfully seized in *their* own right of an absolute and indefeasible  
estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above-granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same  
are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of  
what nature and kind soever; *except as a mortgage for \$2000 to the Farmers*  
*Bank for \$4300 which are hereby assumed by the party of the second part* *her* heirs and  
assigns, against said part of the first part, *their* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
