THIS INDENTURE, Made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, A. D. 1910, between H. P. Kiper and wife Annie C. Kiper of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and A. G. Bunnagamer of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$ 700<sup>00</sup>), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following-described Real Estate, situated in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

to all of Lot Two (2) in Block Two (2) in Grand View Addition  
Tulsa DOLLARS,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said H. P. Kiper & Annie C. Kiper have this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, described as follows:

Above property to be kept insured during the life of this loan,  
for not less than \$500.00 fire and storm payable to mortgagee

One principal note of \$355.00 due February 24th, 1913  
One principal note of \$350.00 due February 24th, 1914

Said note drawing interest at the rate of 8 percent, said  
interest payable semi-annually

Now, if said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and interest thereon, shall then become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the said party of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisalment of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.
